

Free Online Index for *The Primacy of Stewardship* (by Chapter and Pages)

This index for *The Primacy of Stewardship*, by John Manimas, indicates the correct page locations for the hardcover (3rd edition) and paperback (4th edition) and approximate page locations for the larger font soft cover (8" x 10", available only from Northshire Bookstore). The index information is sorted in three different ways:

First, by issue or question, followed by book chapter and pages, then Biblical citation.

Second, by book chapter and pages, followed by Biblical citation.

Third, by Biblical citation, associated with issue and book chapter and pages.

For all three sorts, the information is listed from left to right as follows:

Issue-question, (book) Chapter, (book) Pages, (Biblical) Citation, Gospel, verses
